On Wednesday, March 13, Pasadena Heritage is offering an information seminar covering two topics: how to designate a Landmark District and how to apply for the Mills Act property tax incentive.

In Pasadena, Landmark Districts are historic neighborhoods designated at the local level and protected by zoning laws. Designated properties are typically eligible for grants or tax incentives for rehabilitation projects through programs like the Mills Act.

How do you know if your property or neighborhood is eligible? What is the application process? Speakers and local citizens participating in each of the programs will address these questions and more. The workshop will start at 6:00 p.m. with a discussion on Landmark Districts and will be followed by a discussion on the Mills Act at 7:00 p.m.

The information seminar will be held at the Pasadena Central Library in the Donald Wright Auditorium (at the west end of the main floor). Admission is free, but registration is advised as seating is limited.
